

I have enjoyed Warren Wiersbe's teaching style since he preached at our church more than 45 years ago (before I went to Bible college--wow, I'm old!). I have his entire 2-volume New Testament "BE" commentary in a hardback set, and I was thrilled when I saw the individual books coming to Kindle. This volume on John chapters 1-12 is excellent, probably the best commentary on that book of any I've read. Wiersbe's style is conversational and personal, as though he's explaining something directly to you. This is a book you'll want to read even apart from any serious Bible study; it's just that interesting! Yes, this is one I can definitely recommend.

This is the fourth "Be" series I have studied, and I absolutely loved it. It one thing to read the book of

John, but this series gives you insight into the life of the Saviour. These studies will help you grow and mature.

Dr Warren Wiersbe is one of the most practical teachers of God's Word . Any study from his "Be" series reflects godly wisdom and practical application of biblical truth. His approach emphasizes transformation over information. I recall the first of his studies I was doing with a study group - the study on James; Be Mature. He made a valuable distinction between wisdom and knowledge, that knowledge is the ability to take things apart, while wisdom is the ability to put things together and make them work. That is what you find at hand in any of these studies.

A must needed companion book for the Wiersbe Bible Study Series,in fact this book is a great study on its own!The author is a well versed bible scholar who opens the understanding of the book of John in a clear and concise manner.This book is "lay-person"friendly,it gives insights on chapter by chapter and verse by verse.Be sure to get both books that cover all of John.
