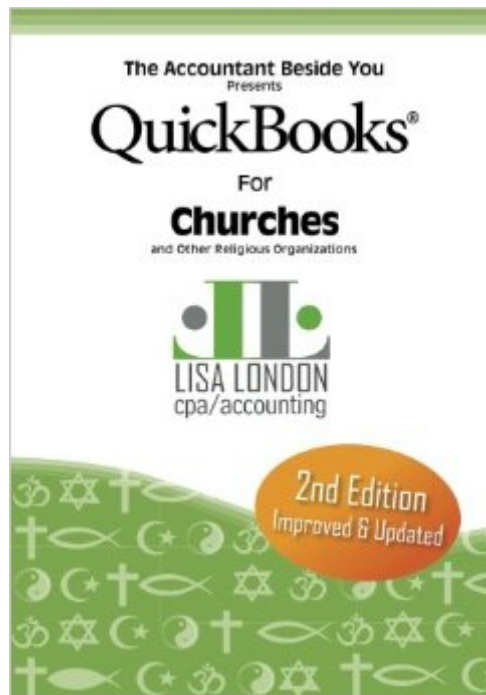

Although I have used Quickbooks for several years, and been the treasurer of a non-profit, this book has taught me features for non-profits that I didn't know existed. It will be a tremendous help in running my own non-profit, as well as in helping set up and in auditing non-profits.

This is exactly what we were looking for in the way of basic information in setting up an accounting system for a new church. With the assistance of a local accounting firm, we will be able to establish a ground level set of accounting records and not have to reorganize the information at a later date. The material is well presented and easy to understand with a minimum amount of accounting knowledge.

Decent resource for subject info that's seems scarce on the internet. But there are quite a few grammatical errors, the pages don't show chapter titles at the top which I find very inconvenient, low quality graphics and an overall cheap, low budget feel to the book. Perhaps the author and publisher could improve these issues with subsequent editions. Not very reader-friendly, but if you can overlook the above, the book does provide some helpful info for those new to church bookkeeping. Could also be clearer with regard to use of classes, jobs, and chart of accounts for tracking church ministries, funds, grants, and the like.

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
